3. Dress appropriately, clean and neat. Please do not wear transparent clothing, really short shorts or skirts and no offensive slogans on clothing. Follow school rules for clothing and you will be fine.
4. Volunteers cannot leave library property during designated break time. Patrons will be counting on you and library staff must know where you are.
5. Remember, what you say out loud can be heard by others. Complaints about other teens, patrons and off-color language are unacceptable.
6. Talking on your cell phone and just plain loud conversations are unacceptable as well.
7. **Remember, you are here to work. If you are not willing to complete your volunteer time and other tasks assigned, you will be sent home.**
