The ballad of Lucy Whipple / Cushman, Karen

In 1849, twelve-year-old California Morning Whipple, is distraught when her mother moves the family from Massachusetts to a rough California mining town.

The courage of Sarah Noble / Dalgliesh, Alice

In her letters to a Vermont friend, eighth grader Dossi, a Russian, Jewish immigrant living in the Lower East Side of New York City in 1910, shares her thoughts about her new brother-in-law, the diphtheria epidemic, and the Triangle Shirtwaist Factory fire.

Sarah, plain and tall / MacLachlan, Patricia

When their father invites a mail-order bride to come live with them in their prairie home, Caleb and Anna are captivated by their new mother and hope that she will stay.
